GIFT AID

What is Gift Aid?

Gift Aid replaces former arrangements for covenanting gifts and subscriptions, by allowing the beneficiary to recover the base rate of tax paid on a 'gift'. If you are a UK tax payer you can increase the value of a donation by 28p for every £1.00 donated. Please complete the form below if you wish to claim tax on your gift at no extra cost to yourself.

GIFT AID NOTES

1. You **MUST** pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the British Society for Geomorphology reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1.00 you give).
2. You **MUST NOT** reclaim your subscription to the British Society for Geomorphology against your income tax
3. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the British Society for Geomorphology in writing.
4. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains tax equal to the tax the British Society for Geomorphology reclaims, you can cancel your declaration.
5. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
6. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid relief, ask the British Society for Geomorphology. Or ask your local tax office for leaflet RI 65.
